Redds created to lay their eggs after fanning off the layer of sediment.

These pipes are designed to be under water, with a cage to prevent the beaver from plugging them up. The floating bulrushes with the help of a westerly wind, pushing down stream have rendered this engineered system to be in effect nonfunctioning!
